

Modern Times, Inc. (MTI) has completed the MWBE-SDVOB Good Faith Efforts (GFE) for the subject RFP and has identified seven (7) firms for LLTJV's consideration as sub-tier bidders, all of whom are currently MWBE-SDVOB certified.

The GFE activity consisted of the following:

- Notice of Interest (NOI) Email sent on January 18, 2019 to all New York State certified MWBE-SDVOBs (about 8,000 certified firms in total) and other LLTJV registered firms.
- 150 certified MWBE-SDVOB firms were contacted that, based on information contained in the NYS MWBE-SDVOB directories, perform the scopes of work needed for the subject RFP. The calls, including follow-up calls, were performed during the following timeframe: January 18, 2019 – January 25, 2019.
 - The search criteria to identify 150 firms for the call effort include the following NAICS and keywords: "cleaning service", NAICS 236210 OR 562111 OR 562910 OR 561720.

From the above effort, MTI identified twenty-three (23) interested firms for the subject RFP. MTI performed follow up calls to each interested firm to assess capacity and ability to support the scopes of work for the subject RFP and, based on these calls, has identified the following:





GREEN FOREVER

Nikita Floyd grew up in the lawn care business. Starting at age 12, he worked for his father in downtown Washington, D.C., then ventured out on his own when he was only 19 years old. With little more than a Hechinger lawn mower and a K-mart weed trimmer, Nikita put up flyers, got referrals and as one referral led to another, he soon found he had laid the groundwork for his own company: Green Forever.



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Purple Line is a 16-mile light rail line that will extend from Bethesda in Montgomery County to New Carrollton in Prince George's County. It will provide a direct connection to the Metrorail Red, Green and Orange lines, as well as MARC, Amtrak, and local bus services. The Purple Line will operate its light rail vehicles mainly in dedicated or exclusive lanes, allowing for fast, reliable transit operations. Most of the alignment will be at the road way level, though short segments will be elevated or underground. Twenty-one stations are planned along the route, creating new


